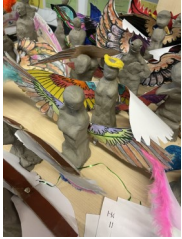


Thank you to all staff involved in organised the wonderful event, and to parents for food and drink donations this week!
