This week's wonderful work



the Power Maths scheme.




Year 5 have been creating some fantastic setting descriptions within their English lessons.



Year 2 have been looking at hidden sugars in drinks for their DT topic.










In Science this week, year 4 have been looking at the human body and naming the body parts.
