Year 4 have been creating unique signatures in the style of Miró.



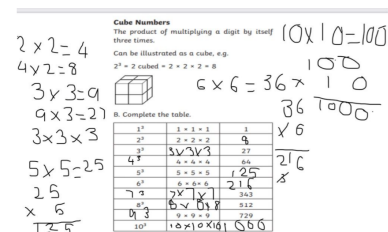
Year 1 have been creating pieces of art using 2D shapes.



A fantastic penguin fact file by one of our year 1 pupils.

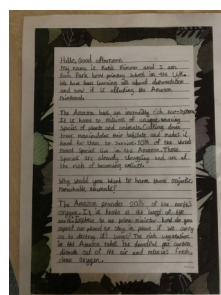


An informative piece of writing by one of our year 2 pupils.
