Can I ask that Parents are mindful about the use of **language** on the playground at the start and end of the school day.

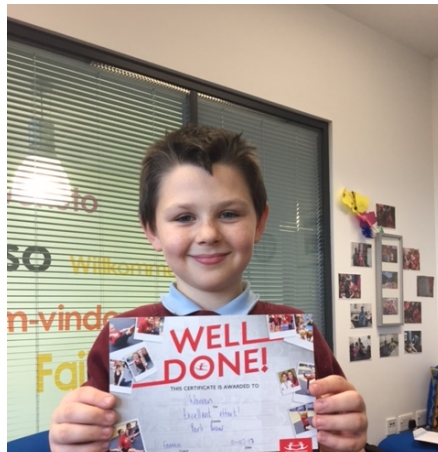
Despite doors being closed the school vents allow voices to carry into the classroom for ears of children and staff.

Year 6 Maths Challenge

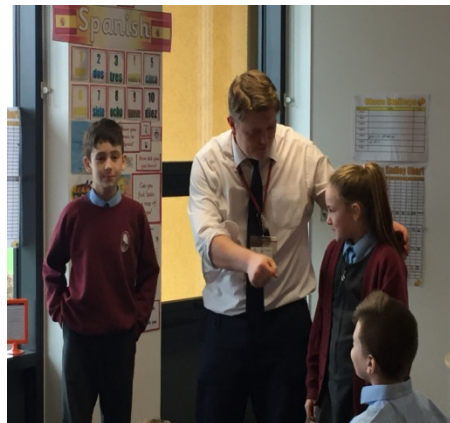
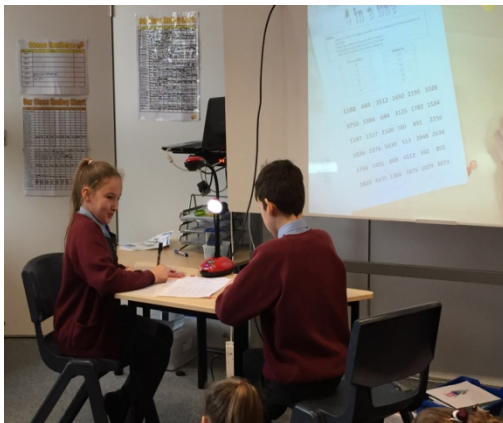
