Here are a few helpful hints for when your child starts Nursery.

The children are required to wear a [school uniform](#) as follows:

- Boys: Maroon Park Brow jumper, blue polo t-shirt, maroon tracksuit bottoms or grey trousers/shorts.
- Girls: Maroon Park Brow jumper or cardigan, blue polo t-shirt, maroon tracksuit bottoms or grey pinafore or skirt, red and white gingham dress for the summer months.
- The children will **always** have the option to play outside so please send them into Nursery with a warm coat when needed and shoes appropriate to the weather.

A waterproof puddle suit and wellies are also highly recommended. These can be left in school so that they are always available for your child to use.



- The children often spend a lot of time putting on and taking off shoes and jumpers as they transition between inside and outside, play in the water area, dress up in role play outfits etc. With this in mind –
Please label ALL of your child's clothing including shoes.
- Our primary way of staying in touch with parents is through an APP called 'Seesaw'. We send newsletters, reminders, photographs etc. through this APP and parents can also send us photographs of things their children are doing at home, which we can then share with the class.
- We will collect **snack money** of £1.50 on a Monday so please send this into school in an envelope marked with your child's name.
- Snack examples – Mon – ham sandwich, Tues - cheese and crackers, Weds - brioche, Thurs – Jaffa cakes/gingerbread men, Fri - toast
- Fresh fruit is always available, as is milk or water.
- **Nursery sessions**- AM: 8.30am-11.30am (Doors close at 8.40am / open at 11.20am)
PM: 12.30pm-3.30pm (Doors close at 12.40pm / open at 3.20pm)
30 hr sessions - 8.30am-11.30am (LUNCH) 12.30pm-3.30pm
(Doors close at 8.40am / open at 3.20pm)
- Children are **dropped off** at the nursery gate as experience has taught us that saying goodbye at the gate and walking in with their friends makes it easier for them to transition from their adult to us.

Safety

- Children **MUST** be collected from nursery by an adult known to the nursery staff. If a different adult, who we haven't met before, will be picking up your child it is really important that you inform the nursery staff and supply the new adult, and us, with a password.

Toileting

- Although most children arrive at Nursery able to take care of their toileting needs (with a little help), there may still be accidents on occasions. With this in mind can you please ensure your child always has a spare set of clothes to be left in a bag on their coat peg. If your child is still in nappies please also provide us with spare nappies and wipes.

Illness
